North Bound Driving instructions:

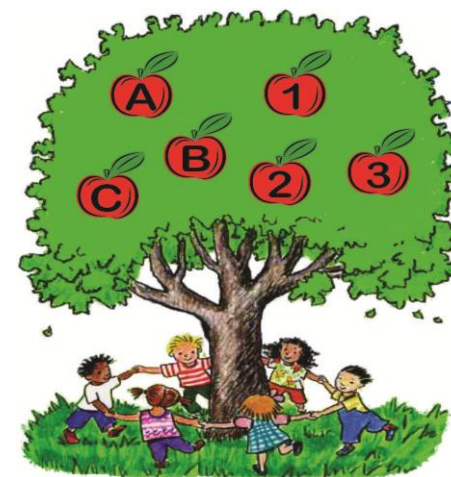
Travel North on I35 and take the McNeil Road (251a/251) Exit, Continue driving North on I35 frontage road until Hester's Crossing traffic light, Make a Left turn on Hester's Crossing, Continue driving West on Hester's Crossing until Rawhide Drive traffic light, Make a Right turn on Rawhide Drive and our school will be on your left hand side.

South Bound Driving instructions:

Travel South on I35 and take the TX-45/Hester's Crossing/TX 1-Loop Exit, Continue driving South on I35 frontage road until Old West Drive, Make a Right Turn on Old West Drive, Continue driving West on Old West Drive until Rawhide Drive, Make a Left turn on Rawhide Drive and our school will be on your right hand side.
